



## A Helpful Guide to Financial Aid

Mauna Loa Helicopters is accredited by ACCSC and approved by the Department of Education to offer certain Title IV loan programs such as Direct Loans and Plus Loans. You can learn all about these exciting programs by going to <https://studentaid.gov/understand-aid/types/loans/plus>.

### Step One: Apply to MLH

First you will need to apply to MLH. To do so please complete an online application form: <https://maunaloahelicopters.submittable.com/submit>. In the application, please note you are applying for a Parent Plus Loan.

### Step Two: Complete FAFSA Application

You must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to apply for federal aid, <https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa>. As a result of this process, you will receive a Personal Identification Number (PIN). Please protect the privacy of this number and do not lose it for all future process. Be sure to select the correct award year, the award year will be the two years in which you are planning on attending. Please call our office if you need help determining your award year.

The FAFSA application process will identify your Expected Family Contribution (EFC) as well as several other key aspects that will be used to determine your overall Title IV financial aid eligibility.

To apply for the parent plus loan, parent can go to [studentloans.gov](https://studentloans.gov), sign in and select "Complete the PLUS Request Process"

### Step Three: Inform the School

Once you have completed steps one and two please call the school and notify us, we will then send you an email to begin the process of setting up a student portal for Campus Ivy.

### Step Four: Campus Ivy

MLH will add your name to our student roster with Campus Ivy, you will then receive an email from Campus Ivy to set up your student portal account and upload requested documents.
